20 HOUR TACTICAL CASUALTY CARE IN UNCONVENTIONAL ENVIRONMENTS

Students will learn how to create and execute an effective triage plan, evacuation plan and patient transportation plan. Students will learn how to apply techniques to control life threatening injuries during care under fire in unconventional environments and conditions.
